



ANNEX -10

- Ambassador Davis met with First Deputy Foreign Minister Macovescu on 21 November. Macovescu was highly skeptical of the rumors of an impending Warsaw Pact invasion of Rumania.
- There has been no noticeable change in the propaganda commentary from Bulgaria, East Germany, Hungary and Poland concerning Rumanian affairs. Nor has there been any effort by these countries to manufacture and propagandize a "justification" for the invasion of Rumania as was the case prior to the Soviet invasion of Czechoslovakia.
