2. THE EVALUATION OF THE KH-4 COVERAGE INDICATED ABOVE WAS BASED ON A CURSORY STUDY OF ALL THE KH-4 PHOTOGRAPHY THROUGH MISSION 1034. IF YOUR EVALUATION OF THE PHOTOGRAPHY DOES NOT INDICATE SATISFACTORY COVERAGE, OR IF THE UK AREA REQUIREMENT HAS BEEN CHANGED, PLEASE PROVIDE DETAILS TO DIAMC. SPOT CHECK THROUGH MISSION 1036 SHOWS THAT NO NEW COVERAGE HAS BEEN OBTAINED OVER YEMEN AREA; FIRST PRIORITY WILL CONTINUE.
