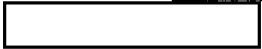

SUBJECT : South China/North Vietnam and Sino-Indian Border
Photographic Reconnaissance, 28 August -
4 September 1967

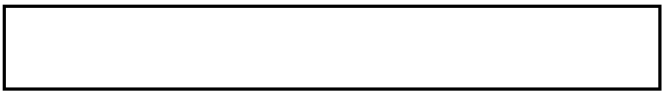

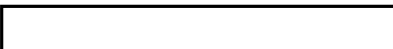

1. The following is a report on photographic coverage of:
 - a. Priority "Base Line" targets in South China and North Vietnam, as defined by the Board on 3 March 1966^a (paras 2-6);
 - b. North Vietnam to detect the introduction of offensive missile systems^b (paras 7 and 8);
 - c. Targets in Laos adjacent to the South China border^c (para 9);
 - d. Targets in the Sino-Indian Border area^d (no coverage).

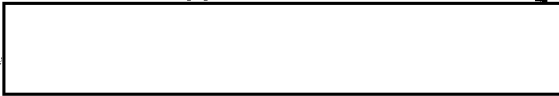



3. Missions during the Period: According to field reporting, five BUMBLE BUG missions, flown 30 August - 3 September, photographed priority targets in the Haiphong area of North Vietnam and the Chan Chiang and Nan Ning complexes in South China.

The BLACK SHIELD mission, flown 31 August, acquired surveillance coverage of two priority targets in North Vietnam and one in South China.

4. Base Line/Surveillance Coverage Reported during the Period: Two  missions, flown 20 and 26 August, acquired surveillance coverage of twelve priority targets in South China.

As noted above the 31 August BLACK SHIELD added three surveillance targets.

BUMBLE BUG and  missions, flown in previous reporting period, acquired surveillance coverage of seven priority targets in North Vietnam.

5. Tab A: Lists all priority targets and shows the status of Base Line/Surveillance coverage as follows:


Column 2 - Underlining indicates base line or surveillance coverage added since the last report.

Column 4 - Base Line coverage since 1 March 1966 shown by date.


Column 5 - The number of times surveillance coverage has been added to the base line photography.

Column 6 - Date of the most recent base line/surveillance quality coverage.

6. The Map at Tab B: Shows the distribution of  targets illustrating the primary areas for lines of communication by shading. The

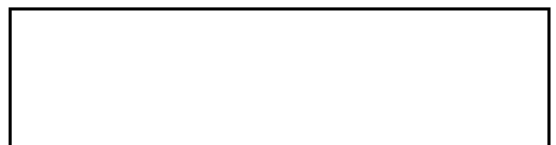

North Vietnam - "Offensive Missiles"

7. There has been no report of photographic detection of the introduction of offensive missile systems into North Vietnam.

8. The Map at Tab C: Shows the  coverage of North Vietnam (80% or better cloud-free) that has been reported in the three week period ending 4 September. This has been reported in accordance with the photo reconnaissance area grid system. In addition to area coverage, the map shows ten targets that could most likely reveal the introduction of offensive missile systems into North Vietnam, the Kun Ming railroad yards, the eleventh target, is at 2501N and is consequently off the map.

9. Targets in Laos Adjacent to South China Border:

A GIANT DRAGON mission on 30 August obtained photography of this area. The results of this mission are not available.
