

1. COMOR has studied the proposal referred to USIB by the Director of DIA on 25 August and subsequently referred to COMOR (USIB-D-41.17/57; COMOR-D-14/13). In the opinion of COMOR, the proposed [REDACTED] effort will complement U.S. Mapping and Charting Programs and should be approved. COMOR is also of the opinion that the number of T-KH clearances requested is commensurate with the work that need be done and the contribution to be expected. It is noted,
