- 1. On I March 1966 the Chairman, Guided Missile and Astronautics Intelligence Committee (GMAIC) addressed a memorandum to the Chairman, COMOR requesting that consideration be given to a KH-4 mission which would provide 10 days of repetitive coverage of the targets shown in Tab A. COMOR has reviewed this request with the National Reconnaissance Office (NRO) in terms of the KH-4 scheduling and the effect this mission might have on the coverage of other targets.
- 2. In the opinion of COMOR, the special GMAIC mission is desirable and NRO has been requested to plan a late May KH-4 mission to provide repetitive 10-day coverage of the targets in Tab A.
