National Intelligence Survey (NIS)

Production Forecast for Fiscal Years 1966, 1967

REFERENCE: USIB-M-334, 24 June 1964

- 1. In accordance with the reference the NIS Committee forwards to USIB the attached NIS Production Forecast which the Committee has developed for fiscal years 1966 and 1967.
- 2. The Forecast extends for the two fiscal years the pattern of production priorities by topics and foreign areas which USIB approved for the FY 1965 production schedule.
- 3. The attachment groups by major world regions the countries on which NIS production is forecast during the two years. Africa will receive the largest production emphasis, accounting for some 26% of total NIS coverage forecast for the period. Latin America is second, with approximately 20% of the total.
- 4. The General Surveys will provide nearly 60% of the total coverage forecast for the two years. This reflects the increased emphasis on the one-volume General Survey as the primary unit in selective and accelerated NIS coverage.
