25X1 24. [Redacted] LIAISON Called David Bushong, Senate Select Committee on Intelligence staff, to ask if there were any final matters that needed to be cleared up before the trip he and Senator James B. Pearson (R., Kansas) are taking next week to Europe. Bushong indicated everything was in order.

25X1 25. [Redacted] LIAISON Called Elliot Maxwell, Senate Select Committee on Intelligence staff, to inquire about the Committee's continuing study of the MKULTRA programs. Maxwell indicated he needed the Agency's help in locating five former CIA officials and he also said he would want to begin next week his review of the other documents which were located along with the MKULTRA files.

25X1 On the matter of a new executive order encompassing PRM-II decisions, Maxwell said the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence wanted to take an active role in the formulation of the proposed executive order and that Chairman Daniel K. Inouye (D., Hawaii) would be calling the Director or Bill Miller, Staff Director, Senate Select Committee on Intelligence, would be calling [Redacted] to discuss how this might be done.

25X1 26. [Redacted] LIAISON Met with Hal Ford, Senate Select Committee on Intelligence staff, who gave me a revised itinerary for Senator Adlai E. Stevenson's (D., Ill.) trip to Latin America beginning 15 August. Senator Stevenson is substituting a stop in Bogota, Colombia for the previously planned stay in Caracas, Venezuela.

25X1 27. [Redacted] LIAISON Tom Moore, Senate Select Committee on Intelligence staff, called to say references had been made to training received by DDO personnel who are going to handle station bookkeeping. Moore asked to see whatever training manuals are provided for these personnel.
