19. [redacted] LIAISON Met with Bill Miller, Staff Director, ^{25X1} Senate Select Committee on Intelligence, and gave him materials released under FOIA on the Israeli sinking of the ship Liberty during the 1967 Arab-Israeli war.

I reminded Miller we had not received a letter regarding the use by the Agency of translators. Miller said he would get to that but suggested we proceed based on his oral advice that the Committee felt there was no problem with such use of journalists.

I discussed with Miller the problem of CIA agents testifying at their own initiative, before Congressional committees, as recently happened, and asked him what he felt the Agency's responsibility was. He acknowledged that this was a very ticklish problem and suggested that each case should perhaps be brought to the attention of the NSC and appropriate oversight committees, for resolution on a case-by-case basis.

Several times during the day, I discussed with Miller the need for a Senate Select Committee on Intelligence representative to speak to the EA Chiefs of Station Conference tomorrow. Because the best staff members to make such a presentation were tied up on a priority project, Miller was unable to offer anyone.
