I have just received a letter from Dr. Kenneth J. Ryan, Chairman of the National Commission for the Protection of Human Subjects of Biomedical and Behavioral Research. In his August 24, 1977 letter to me he indicated that the Commission was asked by the National Foreign Intelligence Board to review draft "Guidelines for Human Subject Research Within the Intelligence Community." I would very much appreciate it if you would supply the Senate Select Committee with a copy of the draft "Guidelines". As I am sure you understand, this material is very important to the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence as it prepares charter legislation for the Intelligence Community, especially in light of the material which you recently revealed on Projects ARTICHOKE, BLUEBIRD and MKULTRA.

I am enclosing a copy of the letter which Dr. Ryan sent to me. I would very much appreciate any comments you might have on the suggestions which he made in his letter to me. In addition, I would appreciate a response from the National Foreign Intelligence Board as to the suggestions Dr. Ryan made in his August 23 letter to Mr. Walt Elder.
