## MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR

SUBJECT: Draft DCID No. 1/10, "Procedures and Secretariat for the United States Intelligence Board"

With reference to paragraph 3c(1), O/NE would, of course, prefer not to be bound by any time requirements for the circulation of drafts prior to a USIB meeting. However, if the USIB members feel that preparation for dealing with estimates at a USIB meeting requires that they see papers three working days in advance, we feel that we can live with such an arrangement. However, we trust that it will be understood that any SNIEs or other estimates which are dene on a crash basis will not be subjected to this requirement. We believe that the word "normally" will protect us.
