4. The Chairman reported to the Committee that the National Indications Center List on guided missiles would be published and sent to GMIC for review in about three weeks.

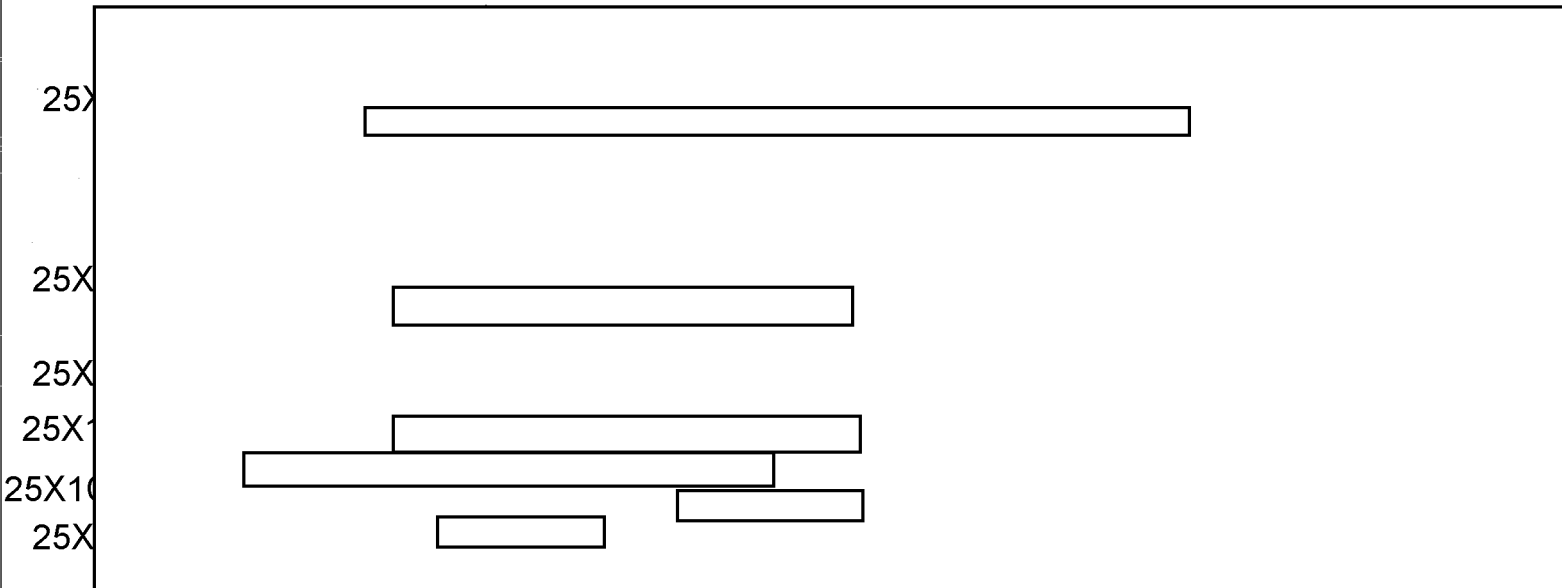
5. Following the review of the NIC Indicator List the Committee will take action on the subject of "Surveillance of the Soviet ICBM Program".
