"The United States aid in turn upset Pakistan which feared the consequences of Indian rearmament. Pakistanis then proceeded to improve their relations with China at the expense of their cordial relations with the United States.

"Thus while the formal rela-tions among the powers involved have undergone but little change in fact the structure in power, especially the International pos-ture of India has fundamentally changed".
