

MEMORANDUM TO: Colonel White


SUBJECT : Document Entitled: Reflections on Some
of the Problems of US Intelligence

1. This is the document I spoke to you about last Friday. The unsigned Memorandum to the Director was drafted with the idea that Admiral Raborn might be interested in the document, and that this kind of explanation for its existence was desirable.

2. About the only sentence I would wish to change prior to a wider circulation is the one within square red brackets on page 80. I still profoundly believe the sentiment but would change the language for a wider audience.
