1. Situation in Iran

Colonel Lillard raised question of desirability of putting out an NIE on Iran or of revising the present estimate. Dr. Kent noted that O/NE had drafted terms of reference to facilitate prompt action in the event the IAC got an NSC request for such an estimate. It was agreed that the situation was too fluid to warrant IAC initiative in scheduling this estimate.
