The SEC GM Committee drafted a proposed estimate of Soviet guided missile reliability. Inasmuch as there had been insufficient time for each member agency to make an adequate check on US guided missile reliability factor which, in the complete absence of intelligence on this subject, must be used as a guide, final Committee approval of this proposed estimate was postponed until Friday, 13 August 1954. no definite Rir Force position toleto Regarding the requested estimate on priorities accorded the various Soviet guided missile categories, the Committee agreed that, considering the dearth of intelligence, this subject had been adequately covered in the basic contribution.
