
UNCONFIRMED INFORMATION RE CUBA BROUGHT TO KBK'S ATTENTION AS OF APRIL 3, 1963

- That 5 Soviets have defected to U.S. by fleeing to Guantanamo Naval Base.
- 2. That missile launchers being stored within supposed barracks build-up 1 & 2 already sent.
- 3. That at least 30 U.S. citizens are still being held in Cuban jails for trumped up offenses.
- 4. That up to 2400-2800 Haitians are currently in training in Eastern Cuba to be part of 14,000-man Latin America Communist international brigade.
- 5. That despite some Soviet withdrawals of military personnel, none of the combat troops have been withdrawn, that overall Soviet military personnel have not been substantially reduced, and that the overall status of Soviet forces in Cuba now is stronger and better coordinated than it was in January.
- from Dominican Republic, backed by lots of money, either from United States or Dominican Republic. Plan is to put Magloire back in, led by General Leon Cantavi. Colonel Paul Reece Cassogonal, Antonio Rodriguez Echesal.
- 7. That Cuban ships with personnel, including terrorists and equipment aboard leave Cuba and land at will at Yuccatan porta in Maxico without effective surveillance of any kind.
