INTELLIGENCE MEMORANDUM

The Indonesian Situation  
(Report #12 - As of 4:00 EDT)

Sukarno summoned all military commanders in the Djakarta area to Bogar today. Also present at the meeting were First Deputy Prime Minister Subandrio and Second Deputy Prime Minister Leimena. According to the communique issued after the meeting, Sukarno called for "tranquility and order" to settle a situation which "basically involves political issues". This is further indication that Sukarno does not intend to sanction an Army crackdown on the PKI. In his first allusion to the six assassinated generals, Sukarno also stated that "those who fell victim to the so-called 30 September movement are heroes of the revolution".

[redacted] Sukarno himself had originally planned the arrest of the generals but had not intended their murder.

General Suharto today aired the Army's charges of Air Force involvement in the coup attempt over Radio Indonesia. Referring to Sukarno's earlier statement absolving the Air Force of complicity in the plot, Suharto stated that while the service as a whole may possibly be innocent, "elements" of the Air Force were definitely guilty.
