- 5. At the same time the army is continuing its hunt for PKI chief Aidit. An army spokesman reports that he has been seen several times in Central Java, and army forces are attempting to surround him in the area.
- 6. The PKI itself is said to believe that at the moment it is losing the struggle with the army and Indonesian religious groups, but still has many assets, including Sukarno and the politicians closest to him. This relatively sanguine assessment may be an attempt to bolster party morale.
