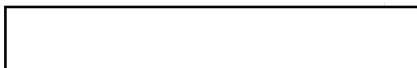

ADHERING TO THE COUNTERREVOLUTIONARY DUAL TACTICS OF THE

CARROT AND THE BIG STICK CHARACTERISTIC OF U.S. IMPERIALISM,

JOHNSON HAS SWITCHED THE STRESS FROM "REPRESENTATIVE DEMOCRACY"

AND "ALLIANCE FOR PROGRESS," THE PET GAME OF JOHN F. KENNEDY,

TO "THE GOUTH LINE" BASED N BRUTE FORCE. THIS FURHTER EXPOSES THE

AGGRESSIVE NATURE OF U.S. IMPERIAISM IN LATIN AMERICA AND DRIVES

HOME THE FACT THAT THE VIGOROUS DAVANCE OF REVOLUTIONARY STRUGGLES

IN LATIN AMERICA HAS MADE IT DIFFICULT FOR WASHINGTON TO DOMINATE

THE CONTINENT THE WAY IT DID IN THE PAST.

AMERICAN REVOLUTIONARY STRUGGLES WITH ARMED AGGRESSION. APRIL LAST,
SHEEDING THE USUAL CLOAK OF "INTER-AMERICAN" ACTION, HE SENT MORE
THAN TWENTY 20 WARSHIPS AND THIRTYFIVE THOUSAND 35,000 TROOPS

TO INVADE THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC. THIS IS WITHOUT PARALLEL IN
U.S.-LATIN AMERICAN RELATIONS IN THE FORTYONE 41 YEARS SINCE
NINETEEN TWENTYFOUR 1924. ITS BRUTALITY SURPASSED THE MASSACRE
PERPETRATED BY U.S. OCCUPATION TROOPS IN PANAMA IN JANUARY LAST
YEAR, DURING WHICH MORE THAN THREE HUNDRED 300 PANAMANIAN WERE
KILLED OR WOUNDED.

THE AGGRESSION AGAINST THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC HAS SET OFF A
WORLDWIDE STORM OF PROTEST, MORE POWERFUL THAN THAT AGAINST THE
PANAMA INCIDENT. EVEN WITHIN U.S. RULING CIRCLES THERE ARE
PEOPLE WHO ARE ALARMED AND WHO ADMIT THAT THE AGGRESSION HAS
LANDED WASHINGTON IN A STATE OF GREATER ISOLATION AND HAS HAD
FAR-REACHING CONSEQUENCES IN EVOKING A DEEPER HATRED FOR THE
UNITED STATES IN LATIN AMERICA.

IN SPITE OF THIS, THE JOHNSON ADMINISTRATION HAS MADE CLEAR
ITS READINESS TO CRACK DOWN ON THE LATIN AMERICAN
REVOLUTIONARY MOVEMENT AND REPEAT THE DOMINICAN INCIDENT IN THE FUTURE.
RECORDING THIS UNCONCEALED INTENTION, THE U.S. HOUSE OF
REPRESENTATIVES PASSED A RESOLUTION ON TWENTYONE 21 OCTOBER
DECLARING THAT ARMED FORCE WOULD BE USED TO INTERVENE
INDIVIDUALLY OR COLLECTIVELY IN LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES UNDER

THE PRETEXT OF COMBTING COMMUNISM.

ANOTHER HALLMARK OF THE JOHNSON ADMINISTRATION'S "TOUGH IS ITS ENERGETIC SUPPORT FOR LATIN AMERICAN MILITARY DICTATORSHIPS. NOT RPT NOT LONG AFTER JOHNSON ASSUMED POWER, THOMAS MANN, THE ARCHITECT OF THE PRESENT U.S. LATIN AMERICA POLICY AND NOW UNDER SECRETARY OF STATE, MADE IT CLEAR THAT THE UNITED STATES FLET NO NEED TO MAKE ANY DISTINCTION BETWEEN DICTATORSHIPS AND "DEMOCRATIC REGIMES." AS LONG AS THEY SUITED ITS OWN INTERESTS. THUS MILITARY COUP D'ETATS WERE ENGINEERED AND MILITARY REGIMES FOSTERED.

AT THE END OF MARCH LAST YEAR, THE JOAO GOULART GOVERNMENT OF BRAZIL WAS OVERTHROWN BY REACTIONARY BRASSHATS AT THE BECK AND CALL OF WASHINGTON. LAST NOVEMBER A U.S.-ENGINEERED COUP IN BOLIVIA LED TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MILITARY JUNTA HEDED BY THE PRO-AMERICAN GENERAL RENE BARRIENTOS. THE CASTELO BRANCO GOVERNMENT OF BRAZIL HAS COME TO BE WASHINGTON'S MOST FAVORED WATCHDOG IN LATIN AMERICA.

ARMIES OF FIVE CENTRAL AMERICAN COUNTRIES (WITHOUT PANAMA--
PARENTHESES AS RECEIVED) INTO A COMBINED FORCE IN EARLY JULY.
UNDER ITS DIRECTION, ARGENTINE ARMY COMMANDER IN CHIEF ONGANIA
VISITED ONE SOUTH AMERICAN NATION AFTER ANOTHER AND HIS ACTIVITY LED
TO THE SIGNING IN AUGUST OF A PACT BETWEEN BRAZIL AND ARGENTINA
FOR JOINT MILITARY ACTION AGAINST "COMMUNISM."

IN ADDITION, THE UNITED STATES IS PRESSING FOR THE ADOPTION
OF A RESOLUTION FOR THE FORMATION OF A "STANDBY INTER-AMERICAN FORCE"
AT THE INTER-AMERICAN CONFERENCE SCHEDULED FOR SEVENTEEN 17

NOVEMBER.

THIS UNDISGUISED POLICY OF AGGRESSION IS NOW THE SOUL OF ALL U.S. POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC ACTIVITIES ON THE CONTINENT. MOST OF THE U.S. FUNDS EARMARKED FOR THE "ALLIANCE FOR PROGRESS" HAVE GONE TO THE PRO-AMERICAN MILITARY DICTATORSHIPS, WITH THE CASTELO BRANCO REGIME RECEIVING THE LION'S SHARE. IT HAS BEEN REPORTED THAT THE CASTELO BRANCO GOVERNMENT, IN ITS FIRST FOUR MONTHS ALONE,

GOT THREE HUNDRED FIFTY 350 MMILLION DOLLARS IN "AID" FROM WASHINGTON. THE PRESENT DOMINICAN PROVISIONAL GOVERNMENT WAS GRANTED TWENTY 20 MMILLION DOLLARS ON THE SECOND DAY AFTER ITS FORMATION UNDER THE U.S. WHIP.

THE NUMBER OF U.S. SPIES AND SPECIAL AGENTS SENT TO LATIN AMERICA AS MEMBERS OF THE "PEACE CORPS" TOTALLED THREE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SIXTYSEVEN 3,967 LAST YEAR, THE BIGGEST NUMBER AMONG ALL THE CONTINENTS OF THE WORLD.

TO WASHINGTON'S CHAGRIN, ALL THESE ACTIVITIES PRODUCED AN EFFECT QUITE CONTRARY TO ITS WISHES. THE "TOUGH LINE" ITSELF WAS FORMULATED AGAINST WHAT THE U.S. PRESS DESCRIBED AS "ANTI-AMERICAN SENTIMENTS" AND "GROWING DESIRES FOR INDEPENDENCE THROUGH WHATEVER MEANS" IN LATIN AMERICA. THE NEW YORK TIMES THEN WROTE GLOOMILY ABOUT THE PROSPECTS OF THIS LINE: "THE FACT THAT THE AREA IS SO CRITICAL WAS OUTSIDE THE CONTROL OF POLICIES OF THE UNITED STATES. THE WISEST POLICIES, THE BEST PLANNING, AND THE MOST EXPERT ADMINISTRATION COULD NOT RPT NOT HAVE PREVENTED THE REVOLUTIONARY

FERMENT AND THE ECONOMIC, POLITICAL AND SOCIAL PROBLEMS."

REPORT HAD THIS TO SAY ON TWENTYTHREE 23 AUGUST: "U.S. OFFICIALS
PRIVATELY EXPRESS DEEP CONCERN OVER THE SITUATION. THEY SAY IT

ON 6 SIX NOVEMBER ROBERTO COPELLO, RADIO PUEBLO COMMENTATOR, CRITICIZED THE UNITED STATES FOR ITS LACK OF FORESIGHT IN REGARD TO THE SPREAD OF COMMUNISM IN LATIN AMERICA (ITEM FILED). ALSO ON 5 FIVE NOVEMBER AN ARTICLE WRITTEN BY FEDERICO CARCA GODOY WAS READ. THIS ARTICLE REVIEWED THE HISTORY OF COMMUNISM AND OF THE EFFORTS MADE BY LOCAL COMMUNISTS.
