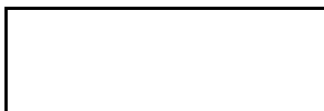

4. We believe the Cubans had about 50 cruise missiles divided among the four original coastal defense sites. These missiles have a long shelf life because of the nature of their propulsion system. It is unlikely that the missile transporters spotted at the Guanabo site during the [Redacted] mission carry new additions to the Cuban cruise missile inventory.
