



West Germany - Eastern Europe: West Germany is showing increased interest in joining the trend toward easing credit restrictions against European Communist countries. An interministerial committee in Bonn has come up with a recommendation to permit the advancement of five-year credits to the USSR and, in individual cases, longer term credits to other East European countries. Chancellor Erhard and his top advisers are for the moment, however, in favor of maintaining existing restrictive policies until another attempt has been made to "harmonize" the credit policies of all Western countries.
