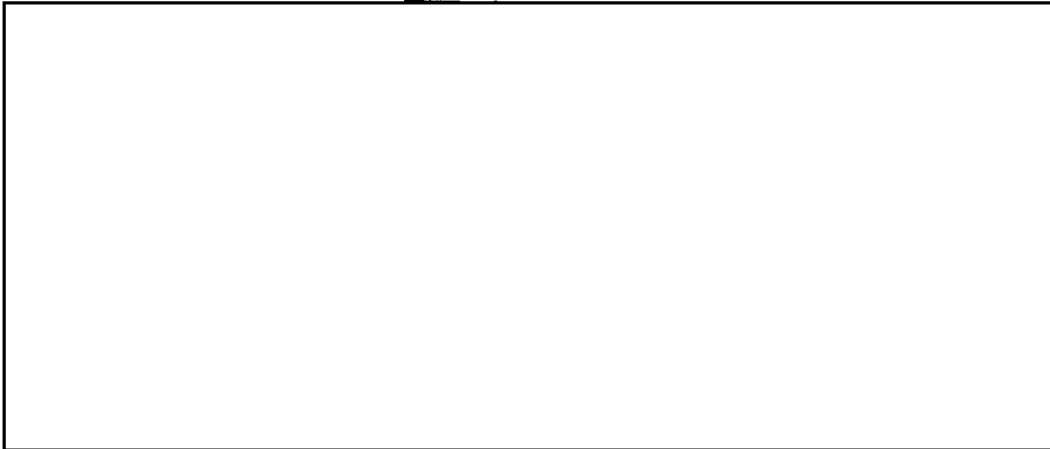

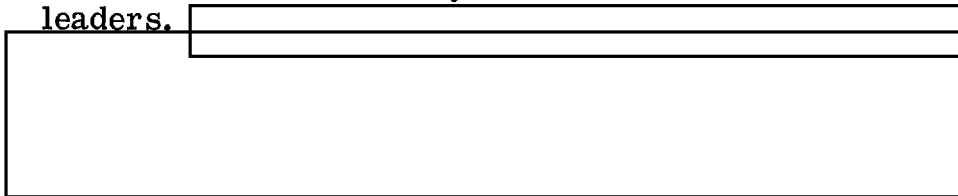

Guatemala: The arrests of right-wing National Liberation Party (MLN) leaders are likely to pose a serious political problem for the Mendez regime. The Guatemalan security forces' inability to find and arrest leftist extremists will probably cause rightist elements to complain that the right rather than the left is being threatened. President Mendez banned a dormant left-wing party on 4 November probably to ease the tension caused by the arrest of the MLN leaders.
