NOTE

India: Prime Minister Indira Gandhi's assumption of the sensitive Home Ministry portfolio appears designed to head off friction within the Congress party hierarchy. The resignation of Gulzarilal Nanda from the post on 8 November followed criticism of his apparent weakness in dealing with the recent violence in New Delhi. Mrs. Gandhi may delay a permanent appointment until after the general elections next February.
