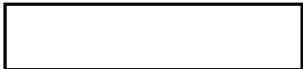

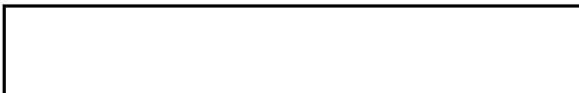

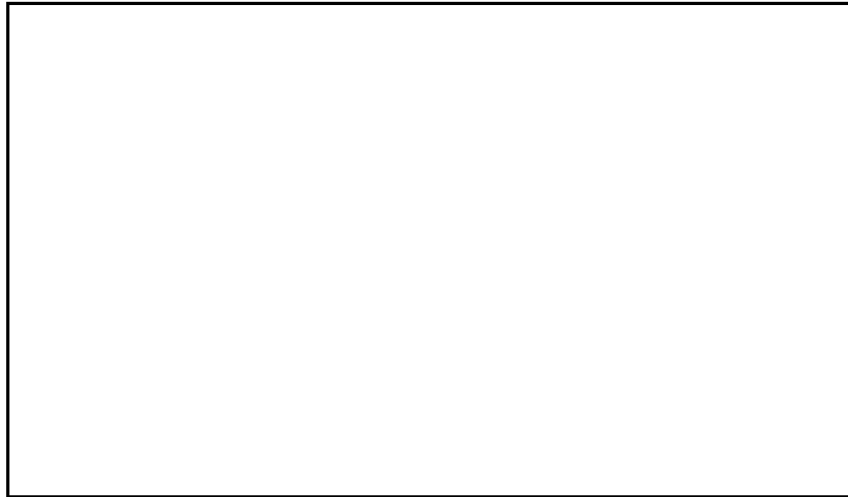

NOTE

Cyprus: Trouble may be brewing over the withdrawal of Greek "illegal" troops from Cyprus. Turkish officials are concerned that all these Greek forces may not be withdrawn by 18 January as agreed between the two countries last month. Noting that none have been taken off the island since 20 December, Ankara has warned that emotions would again flare up if the Turkish people become aware that the evacuation is not proceeding. With only two weeks of the 45-day withdrawal period remaining, at least half--and perhaps substantially more--of the Greek "illegals" are still on the island.
