BERLIN: The Soviet representative at the four-power advisers' meeting on 6 March reintroduced into the discussion a series of stiff formulations regarding a possible Berlin agreement. He openly admitted that he was marking time, apparently to increase pressure on the West to get intra-German talks under way on the Berlin issue. Meanwhile, negotiations between the West Berlin Senat and the East German Government on Easter visits to East Berlin began on 6 March but produced no immediate results. They will be resumed later this week.
