- 1 - Military camping area :
 - a) Barracks.
 - b) Stable.
 - c) Fountain
- 2 - The area, isolated by barbed wire :
 - a) The building for the civil guard.
 - b) A building, but for what it was used, is not known.
- 3 - Vineyard
- 4 - The area, where the buildings of T.E.Z.S. are located .
- 5 - Transforming (electrical) center.
- 6 - A building in front of which there is a sign, saying "Fired without any warning!".
- 7 - Hospital
- 8 - A hut, where foods and refreshments are sold.
- 9 - M.T.S. (Machine and tractor center)
- 10 - Driving practice area of the D.O.S.O. Organization.
- 11 - KAKARAI district
- 12 - Tavern
- 13 - Wool and cotton-wool combs.
- 14 - Buildings and work-shops of PROMKOMBINAT (The union of the handicrafts experts' Organization).
- 15 - A Building having two flats, belonging to PROMKOMBINAT.

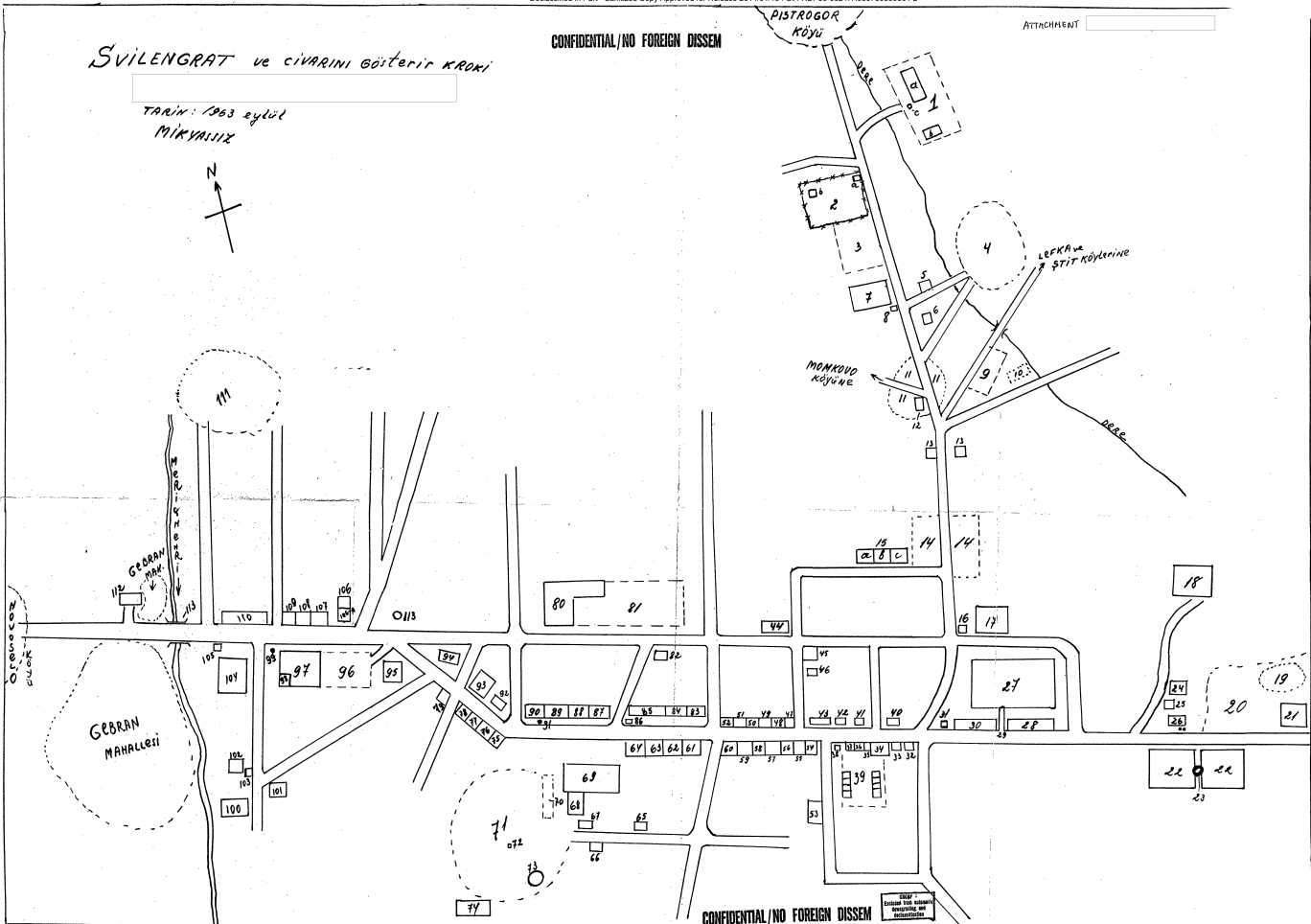

The explanation of the sketch, showing "MARITSA IZTOK" thermo electric station, and the briket factory :

- A - Artificial lake.
- B - Dam.
- C - The canal, where the hot water, from the thermo electric station, flows.
- D - The road to GARA GILIBOVO.
- E - The road to ROZOF KLADNETS village.
- F - The road to TROYANOVOK village.
- G - Double railroad to TROYANOVOK coal mine.
- H - Railroads to GARA RAZDELNA.

T.E.TS. (Thermo electric station) "MARITSA IZTOK" :

- 1 - Station building.
- 2 - 4 chimneys. One of these has a height of 180 m.
- 3 - Barbed wire.
- 4 - A building, having single flat, used as the dining-room for the labourers.
- 5 - SPESTOVNA KASA (Savings Bank)
- 6 - A garden, in which there are some banks for sitting.
- 7 - Pool
- 8 - Militia station, responsible for protecting the combine.
- 9 - The buildings, where the documents are controlled, at the entrance gate.
- 10 - The bus-stop, for the buses having toures between GARA GILIBOVO and the briket factory.
- 11 - Two iron pipes between the electric station and the briket factory. These are places at th a height of 4. from the ground. These pipes stand on concrete bases.
- 12 - The elevator strap line to thermo electric station. This way the coal dust formed during the production at the briket factory, is sent to the thermo electric station in order to be burned.
- 13 - The machine department of the elevator installation.
- 14 - The area, where there was a construction activity even in June, 1963, concerned with the widening process of the thermo electric station.

BRIKETNA FABRIKA "MARITSA IZTOK" (The factory, where briket is produced, out of lignite coal):

- 1 - Administration of the briket factory. The building has 3 flats.

- 5 -

On the lower flat there are the offices of the officials, and the laboratory for the electrical processes.

On the third flat there is a chemistry laboratory, and the director's room is on the 2nd floor.

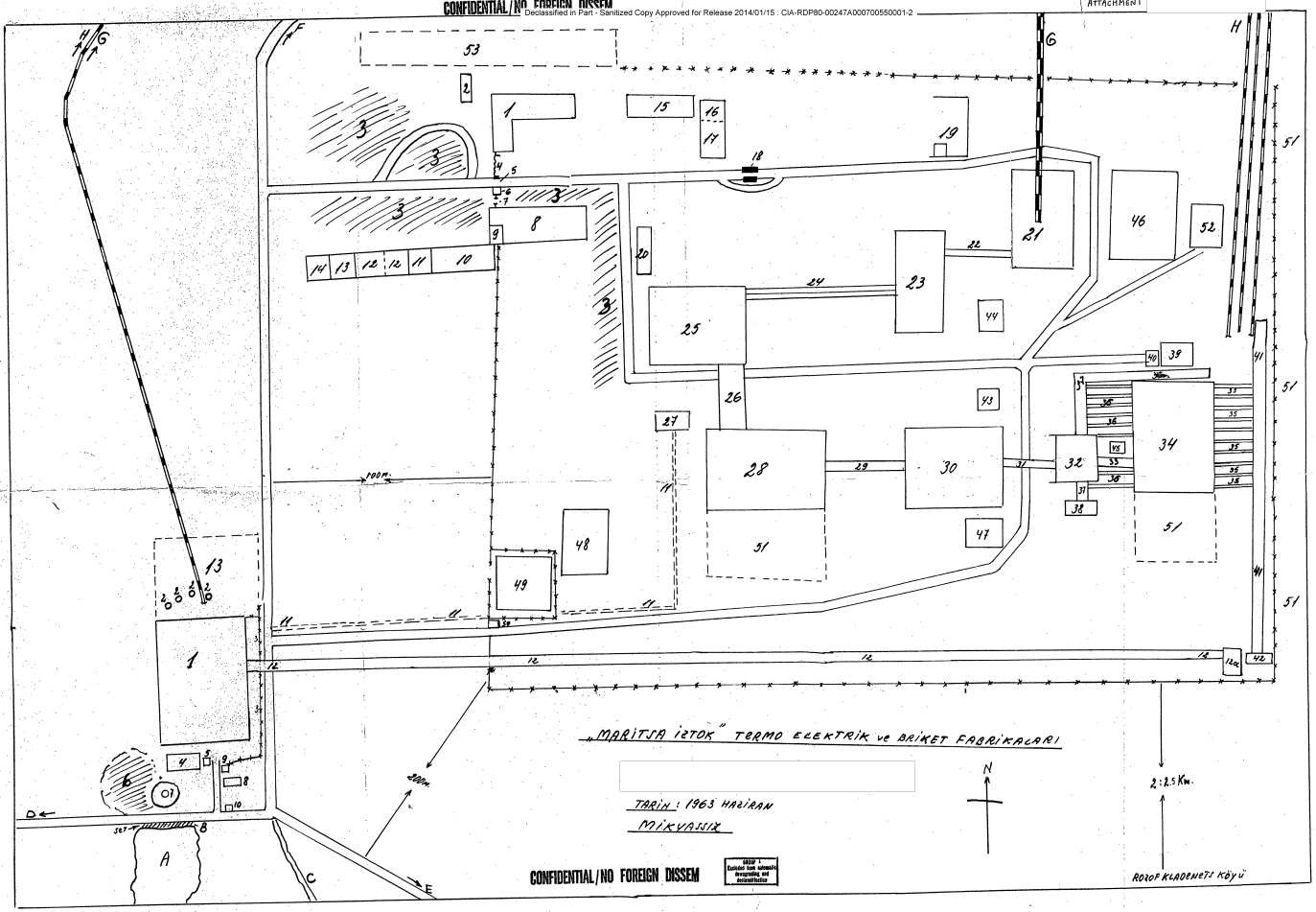
- 2 - Health check-up building, having a single flat.
- 3 - A garden, in which there are some banks for sitting.
- 4 - Auto-park places, in the forms of sheds, surrounded with corrugated metal plates. Here there are two trucks and one VOLGA marked automobile.
- 5 - The gate through which the transportation means pass.
- 6 - Bridge. On this bridge they check-up the documents.
- 7 - The gate used by the labourers for coming in and going out.
- 8 - A building having a single flat. This building has a basement too, which is used as a dining room. On the upper flat, some meetings are arranged in the hall. When there are meetings the basement is used as the dining-room.
- 9 - Kitchen.
- 10 - A building, having a single floor, which is used as a dining-room, when necessary.
- 11 - A small store, where clothes are sold. Here they sell socks, under-garments, shirts and etc.
- 12 - Canteen where refreshments and some kinds of pies are sold.
- 13 - Barber's shop for men.
- 14 - SPORTEN CLUB, where there are a few tables for playing chess, and one table-tennis table.
- 15 - Fire-brigade of the factory.
- 16 - A building, having a single flat, where the battery charging department is.
- 17 - Auto garage, in front of which there is a shed. This shed is also used as a park.
- 18 - A platform, near the highway, which is used for washing the transportations means. The transportation means in order to be washed, go up to this platform in an incline.
- 19 - REAGENTNO STOPANSTVO, spare parts depot. The building has a single flat, and there is a depot employee in charge of the depot.
- 20 - Bath
- 21 - They call this part PRIEMN. TSBNTIR or OBEKT KULA LDNO. This building is used for unloading the coal, brought here from TROYANOVVO mine by wagons. The wagons go up to the top of this building, and the coal is unloaded into a private mouth on the top. there are 6/6 depots in the forms of cells here too.
- 22 - Single elevator belt installation.

- 6 -

- 23 - The section, where the coal is broken, called EDRO TROSENE. This part is also known as NULO DVE section.
- 24 - The installation, where there is possibly the double elevator belts.
- 25 - The main building of the first part, called DREBNO TROSENE or OBLKT NULA TRI. Here the coal is made into dust and sifted.
- 26 - The installation, where three belts of three elevators pass.
- 27 - The section, where the steam, from the thermo electric station, is collected and pumped to the factory. They call this section either KONDEZNI POMPI or KONDEZNO OTDELENIE.
- 28 - The section, called either NULA CETIRI or SUJILNO OTDELENIE, which belongs to VTORI TSEH. Here the coal dust is dried, and it becomes very hot.
- 29 - Elevator installation. The installation has two flats, and two belts pass from here.
- 30 - The section called either NULA PET or OHLADITELNO OTDELENIE, which belongs to VTORI TSEH. Here the coal is made cold.
- 31 - Elevator installation, with double belts passing.
- 32 - The section, called MEJDINKAN BUYER, [REDACTED] 50X1-HUM
- 33 - Elevator installation, with double belts passing.
- 34 - Pressing section. They call this section either PRAKOP UJEN or OBLKT NULA SEST. Here the coal dust is pressed into the moulds (brikets) having dimensions; 10x5x4. In this section there are 18 presses, 9 on the east and 9 on the west.
- 35 - The moulds, coming out of the presses, slip through the gutters to the elevator belt. Here the coal, which will be loaded to wagons, pass too.
- 36 - The moulds, coming out of the presses, slip through the gutters to the elevator belt. These brikets are sold to the factories in retail, and are loaded to the trucks.
- 37 - The belt, delivering the brikets to the depot, which is located near the retail selling place.
- 38 - The motor department of the belt, which delivers the brikets to the retail selling place. On the lower flat, there is a repair-shop, belonging to this department.
- 39 - The depot, where the trucks load coal. The trucks can go under this depot, and through a cover, which opens by a lever, they are immediately loaded.
- 40 - Steelyard.

- 7 -

- 41 - A very slow ^(moving) rotating elevator, made of wire, and which is called, OHLADITELNA LENTA.
- 42 - The machine department, of the slow rotating elevator, made of wire.
- 43 - Transforming center getting the current from the thermo electric station. The current coming from this transforming center is of 6 thousand volts. This transforming center gives a current of 6000 volts to the briket factory and the other two transforming centers, and also by means of its transformer it supports VTORI TSEH (second section) with a current of 380 volts. There are nine transformers at this center.
- 44 - Another transforming center, changing the 6000 volts of current, which it receives from the main transforming center, to 380 volts, and which sends it to PIRVI TSEH (first section) installations. There are six transformers in this center.
- 45 - The transforming center, which distributes the currents of 6000, and 380 volts, it receives from the main transforming center, to the press sections. There is no transformers in this center. These presses here, operate with the current of 6000 volts.
- 46 - The repair-shop of the factory. Here there are lathes, milling-machines, and etc. The electric motor are repaired here, and there is also a tin section.
- 47 - The section, where the iron surfaces of some parts are polished. Here they smooth the deformed surfaces of the tools, used by the coal pushers, and in this process they use some special stones.
They call this section; SLAYFOVALNIYA.
- 48 - The building, where they are pumps, taking water from the artificial lake, on the south, and distributing it to the briket factory.
- 49 - The construction-site of the department, which is concerned with mounting the machines, building of the briket factory and the thermo electric station.
- 50 - The guard-box at the gate, through which the trucks, loading coal, come and go.
- 51 - The areas, where, according to the plans, concerned with widening the briket factory, some new buildings and additional installations will be constructed.
- 52 - The depot for some kinds of tools, and some small spare parts.
- 53 - The area, where the spare machines are kept. These will be mounted, when the factory is widened.
