2. Naval Artillery Training Center in the Prevlaka area on the Boka Kotorska

50X1-HUM

Training courses for all military units of Eastern Yugoslavia are given at this Center. These courses average 4 months in length and are attended by approximately 200 officer- and noncommissioned-officer-students. Training includes instruction on a new AA gun produced in Yugoslavia and equipped with radar, as well as on AA missiles of Russian origin

[redacted] about which no details were learned. A new radar installation is currently being erected in an area about 1000 meters west of the Center's caserne, in the direction of the coast. Also in May 1964, two new bunkers were noted which had not been seen in 1963. Other unidentified construction work was also noted.

- 3. Construction of water storage tanks for naval coastal defense posts in the territory inland from the Dalmatian coast.

This work is being carried out by landing infantry and army troops at Slivno, Krstatice, Gornji Rascani (two separate locations), Zagvozd (two large cisterns), Zupa and Biokovsko Selo. The work is scheduled to be completed by winter 1964.

- 4. Radar installations on Mount Kopar (near Pula)

The radar station on Mount Kopar, about 16 km from the center of Pula and 4 km from the village of Premantura, comprises 8 radars of which 3 are American and 5 mobile, mounted on trucks kept in garages on the base. The three American radars are in operation 24 hours a day; the others have only been observed in operation during maneuvers. Two antennas which are connected with the radar station by an underground cable are located on another hill south of the tourist village Postinje, 5-6 km south of Pula.

The radar station is under Lt. Col. Veljko Sarenovic and has a complement of about 20 officers, 30 noncoms, and 60 men. The entire compound is enclosed with barbed wire and guarded by four guard posts.

- 5. Transport company of the IVth Army Corps, with headquarters in Split.
