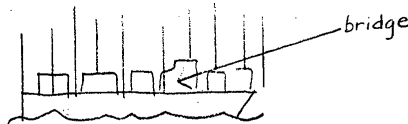

1. [redacted] a SKORYY-class destroyer [redacted] and a probable Q-class submarine [redacted] were underway in the Gulf of Finland. The destroyer [redacted] was near N 60-00, E 28-40 and the submarine [redacted] near N 60-10, E 28-20. [redacted]
2. The vessel sketched below was sighted [redacted] near N 59-55, E 28-40. She had a motorboat hull with about 25 antennas, each approximately 10 meters high, and several box-shaped superstructures on deck.



3. A small maintenance [or coast guard] vessel was seen at anchor near N 60-08, E. 27-52 also on 19 May.
