


8. Suggestion Box: No suggestions were received this week. The total number of suggestions received since the program began on 15 June 1977 is 71. (U)

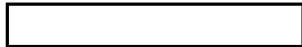

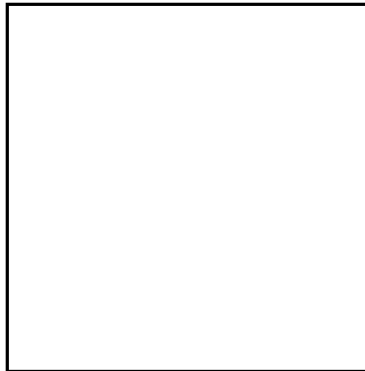
