"At Gdansk the shippards are organized on a different pattern; all the separate small yards are merged into one enterprise. A number of years ago a large dock from the former SCHIHAU shippard was towed to the OSTROW BAZA REMONTOWA at WESTERPLATTE. Thus the BAZA REMONTOWA is directly linked with the SCHIHAU shippard across the canal. A third shippard, the so-called southern yard, is also linked with this large shippard. This means that at present there is only one shippard at Gdansk which is large enough to accommodate large warships.

"The area of the shippard is guarded from wooden watchtowers built round the shippard. These towers are equipped partly with searchlights and partly with powerful lights. At every point on the land side which might be easily crossed by intruders, there are barbed wire barriers. The shippard is also guarded by special patrols with bloodhounds. These patrols and the guards at the main entrance are composed of the "guard of the shippard" (STRAZ STOCZNICMA) and entrance are composed of the proportion of two to one. Sometimes KBW soldiers can be observed guarding the shippard. All guards and patrols are armed with machinal pistols.

"The warships under repair at the Gdansk shipperd are also guarded by the marine posts from the ship's crew. The BAZA REMONTOWA is comparatively less guarded than other parts of the shipperd.

"In order to enter the Gdansk shippard it is necessary to obtain a special permit from the office of the BAZA REMONTOWA. These permits are issued after of the captain of the list of the members of the crew which has been signed by the captain of the ship under repair. The permit must be stamped with the round rubber stamp of the ship and signed by its captain, as well as stamped and countersigned by the shippard guard at the central office of the shippard."
