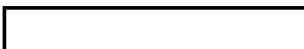
Shortages of materials caused a great loss of production time in December 1953 and January 1954 in the Zellwolle Schwarz (cellulose fiber factory). The chief shortages were in caustic soda and copper salts. Because of these stoppages a Soviet order has not been filled.
