1. Zeiss Ikon, of Dresden, produced about 8,000 proximity fuses in February 1954 which were shipped to the Soviet Union, probably by airplane.
2. Eight completely automatic target cameras were manufactured, also for the Soviet Union, but have not been shipped because Zeiss Jena has not yet delivered the electric exposure meters.
3. There has been no change in the production of curve potentiometers and parts for torpedoes.
