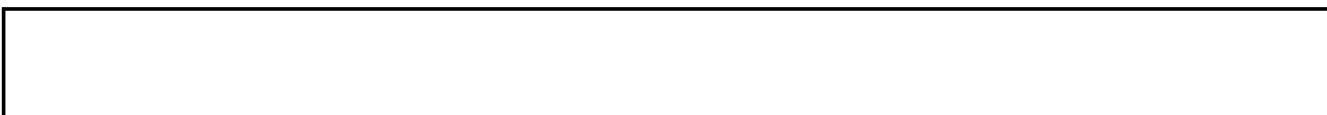

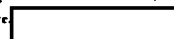
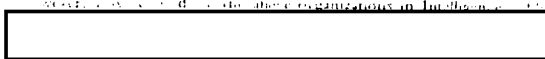


According to statements by a Soviet officer, it appears that the USSR has developed a new short-range defense combat plane for crewless operation. Because of its short length, stated to be seven meters, it is easy to transport. To the question whether a starting ramp was required, and the plane therefore tied to bases, the officer answered that it would take off from a launching carriage. It has a tail assembly like the MIG 15 and delta wings. It is powered by a rocket engine, and in addition has a ram jet pipe astern.

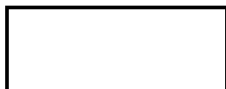

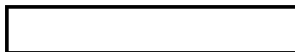
