KOSTOUISOV REPLACED YEFREMOV AS MACHINE TOOL HEAD -- Sovetskaya Estoniya, No 57, 10 Mar 49

PERSONNEL CHANGES IN BELORUSSIA -- Sovetskaya Belorussiya, No 49, 4 Mar 49

The following appointments and administrative changes were made in accordance with decrees of the Presidium of the Supreme Soviet Belorussian SSR:

G. S. Jakhtanov was appointed Minister of Timber and Paper Industry Belorussian SSR and relieved of duties as Deputy Chairman of the Soviet of Ministers Belorussian SSR.

V. S. Zabello was appointed Minister of Communal Economy Belorussian SSR and relieved of duties as Deputy Chairman of the Soviet of Ministers Belorussian SSR.

GENERAL-POLKOVNIK ROMANENKO DIES -- Krasny Flot, No 58, 11 Mar 49

General-polkovnik Prokofiy Logvinovich Romanenko, deputy to Supreme Soviet USSR, died 10 March 1949 after a short illness. Romanenko took part in the German defeat at Stalingrad and in the liberation of Novgorod-Seversk, Gomel', and other cities.
