APRIL COAL GUTPUT IN COMMUNIST AREAS UP; SINKIANG PRICES FALL

COAL PRODUCTION INCREASED -- Hua-shang Pao, 2 May 49

Coal production from the three state-owned coal mines at Men-t'ou-kou was greatly increased during April. At Men-t'ou-kou Mine, the average coal output per miner during the first 10-day period was about 1.16 ton but this was increased to 1.19 tons during the second 10-day period. At Hsi-shan Mine, the total output during the first 10-day period was 2,500 tons but this was increased to 3,480 tons during the second 10-day period. At Ch'eng-tzu mine, the total daily output was little over 100 tons during the first 10 days, but was increased to 172 tons during the second 10-day period.

HORTHEAST COAL MINERS UNION FORMED -- Hua-shang Pao, 4 May 49

The first Coal Miners Conference attended by more than 280 delegates from ten state-Graed and provincial-owned mines at Fu-shun, Pen-ch'i, Hao-kang, Chi-hsi, Ku-ma, Hsi-an, Ru-hsin, Wen-ho, Tiung-hua and Pei-p'iao was held at Shen-yang (Murden) 5-25 April 1949. Aside from setting the 1949 production goal of these mines at more than 10 million tons, the conference established the Northeast Coal Miners Union electing Yang Ch'ang-hun, Ch'en Keng-fu, Chang Shih-han, Chin Chih-fu and 53 others as members of the Executive Committee.

PRICES FALL IN SINKIANG -- Shen Pao, 23 Apr 49

Rumors of impending opening of Sino-Soviet trade relations are reported to have caused a recent sharp decline of prices in Sinklang. In Ti-hua 50 silver yuan will buy one and a third ounces of gold. Twill fabric soils for only 5 silver yuan per bolt.

Minting of silver currency in Sinkiang is being rushed and it is hoped that the new silver year will be in circulation by 1 May. Besides subsidiary silver coins issued at the same time, gold-year notes, old Sinkiang notes, and other locepted currency will continue to be in usa.
