COMMUNISTS WAKE APPOINTMENTS TO PEOPLE'S GOVERNMENTS

HOMAN OFFICIALS NAMED -- Wen-hui Pao, 13 May 49

The Honson People's Government was recently established by the Provisional Central Chine People's Government to control the two cities of K'ai-feng and Chang-shou and the following ten districts: Shan-shou, Lo-yang, Chan-shou, Chen-liu, Sheng-ch'iu, Huai-yang, Huang-ch'uan, Ch'ueh-shan, Hau-chang and Chen-liu, Sheng-ch'iu, Ruai-yang, Huang-ch'uan, Ch'uah-shan, Hau-chang and Ran-yang. Honan People's Government Committee members appointed were: Wu Chih-pu (Ueda: 1206, 9742, 1633), Chen-Tsai-tao (12864, 629, 12051), Jhang Chin (3065, 12380), Pi Shoo-haueh (7520, 1150, 13015), T'ien Feng (7478, 11261), Wang Ewo-hua (7262, 1639, 9921), Liu Ming-p'ang (840, 5935, 3163), P'eng Haiao-ch'ien (3113, 8396, 987), Chi Wen-fu (2653, 4321, 7470), Ho Ch'ung-ahang (11364, 2607, 991), Chang Pai-yuan (3065, 7709, 6396), Yang Shao-ch'iao (5123, 2440, 5548), Chao Wen-fu (11479, 4321, 7470), Sung Lieh (2312, 6831), Kuo Wei-chan (12179, 8879, 7827), Li Iu-san (4735, 1112, 7), Sung Ch'uan (2312, 2762), and Li Pao-kuang (4735, 2405, 567).

The above appointments became effective as of 10 May 1949.

MAN-CHIMC AND HANG-CHOU HEADS APPOINTED -- Wen-hui Pao, 12 May 49

After the establishment of the Man-oning People's Government on 10 May 1949 by the China People's Revolutionary Military Council, Liu Po-ch'eng (840, 228, 3690) was appointed mayor of Man-ching, with K'o Ch'ing-shih (4869, 2984, 4591) and Chang Lin-ohih (3065, 13048; 88) as deputy mayors. They assumed office on 11 May.

The Hang-chou Military Control Commission and the Carrison Command were set up on 7 May 1249. T'an Chen-lin (11172, 13036, 4803) was designated chief of the commission, with T'an Ch'i-lung (11172, 1373, 14876) and Wang Tao-han (7262, 62031, 6223) as deputy chiefs. The garrison commander is Wang Chien-an (7262, 53006, 2309), while T'an Ch'i-lung has been appointed political commissar. Chi P'eng-fei (2108, 14483, 13495) is to hold the positions of deputy commissar and thief of the political section.
