COAL MINERS EXCEED 5-MONTH PLAN

DONBASS MINERS REACH 1950 LEVEL -- Pravda Ukrainy, No 119, 22 May 49

Stalino -- Coal miners of Gorlovka Mine No 3, have attained the mining level set for 1950. Mining has increased nearly 35 percent over 1948.

MOSCOW COMBINE FULFILLS 5-MONTH PLAN -- Moskovskiy Komsomolets, No 64, 24 May 49

On 21 May the "Moskvougol" Combine fulfilled the 5-month plan for coal mining and preparatory work. The average daily coal output increased 12.5 percent over the same period of last year, and labor productivity increased 10.1 percent. During the past 3 months, labor productivity exceeded the prewar standard.

The first to complete the 5-month plan was the "Stalinogorskugol'," "Shcherbakovugol'," and "Oktyabr'ugol'" trusts.

MINERS COMPLETE 5-MONTH PLAN - Izvestiya, No 120, 24 May 49

Miners of the "Tulaugol" Combine have completed the 5-month plan ahead of schedule.

Pravda, No 144, 24 May 49

Tula miners have completed the 5-month plan for preparatory work. The average amount of coal mined per day rose 10.8 percent over the same period of 1948 and labor productivity increased 11 percent. The first to complete the 5-month plan were miners of "Kraanogvardskyugol'," "Skuratovugol'," and "Tovarkovugol'" trusts.

CHELYABINSK MINERS BEAT PLAN -- Komsomol'skaya Pravda, No 121, 25 May 49

Following the example of workers of "Kopeyskugol'" Trust, miners of "Chelyabugol'" Trust have completed the 5-month plan ahead of schedule. Mines No 22, 4-5, 16-23 are among those which have delivered several thousand tons of fuel on the June quota.

Coal production is increasing in the Chelyabinsk basin. Miners of the outstanding mine, No 204, have determined to complete the 9-month plan by 28 August, in honor of Miner's Day.

KUZBASS COAL MINES REPORT SUCCESS -- Krasnaya Zvezda, No 121, 25 May 49

Miners of "Belovugol'" Trust were the first in the Kuzbass to fulfill the 5-month plan for coal mining. The preparatory work program has also been entirely completed. The outstanding mines, "Babanakrovskaya," and imeni 1 Maya have already delivered hundreds of tons of fuel on the June quota.

Miners of the "Anzherougol'" Trust in the Kuzbass fulfilled the 4-month plan ahead of schedule and are delivering a large amount of additional fuel daily. Since the beginning of 1949 tens of thousands of tons of coal above the plan have been mined.
