MORE MACHINERY FOR AGRICULTURE AND FOOD INDUSTRY

NEW MACHINE FOR COTTON CROPS -- Sovetskaya Kirgiziya, No 131, 6 Jul 49

The "Uzbeksel'mash" Plant in Tashkent has begun production of the ODN universal machine for pollinizing and spraying cotton crops. The machine is drawn by a universal tractor and can work 1.3 hectares per hour.

KHARKOV PLANT BUILDS NEW THRESHER -- Leningradskaya Pravda, No 162, 12 Jul 49

The "Serp i Molot" Plant in Kharkov is producing the new all-metal MS-1100 thresher which is equipped with a pneumatic transporter and an automatic device which delivers the sheaves to the barrel.

TADZHIKISTAN MAKES FARM MACHINERY -- Izvestiya, No 153, 1 Jul 49

Machinery and repair plants of the Ministry of Agriculture Tadzhik SSR have begun production of horse-drawn cultivators and hillers with fertilizer-spreading devices of a simplified type.

COTTON-PICKING MACHINE ASSEMBLY ON CONVEYER -- Pravda Vostoka, No 135, 10 Jul 49

The Tashkent Agricultural-Machine Building Plant has completed a main conveyer for assembly of cotton-picking machines.

MOSCOW PLANT MAKES BOILERS FOR SUGAR PLANTS -- Vechernyaya Moskva, No 161, 8 Jul 49

The Moscow Machine-Building Plant of "Glovpischemash" (Main Administration of Machine Building for the Food Industry) has completed its Five-Year Plan. This plant is making equipment for the sugar industry. In 1948, it built three powerful steam boilers for sugar plants. These boilers were formerly imported from abroad. This year it will increase the output of these boilers by several hundred percent. Each boiler can produce 10 tons of steam under a pressure of 25 atmospheres per hour. They will be sent to Voronezh, L'vov, and Kursk

MAKES MACHINES FOR PAPER INDUSTRY -- Leningradskaya Pravda, No 159, 8 Jul 49

The Leningrad Plant imeni "Vtoroy pyatiletki" builds machines for the paper industry. Although this plant successfully fulfills its production program, it is slow in introducing new production methods and in producing new and improved machines.
