NEW PLANTS UNDER CONSTRUCTION
IN DOLNY SLASK

SKILLED WORKERS TRANSFERRED TO DOLNY SLASK -- Rzeczpospolita, No 203, 26 Jul 49

Skilled workers from all parts of Poland are being transferred to Dolny Slask for specialized work in new plants. A new boiler plant will soon be built at the gasworks in Wroclaw. A new chemical plant and the "Rokita" plant are being erected at Brzeg Dolny. The iron foundry at Pafawag is being rebuilt and will be ready for use on 30 September. In Wroclaw two plants for processing gravel and rubble into building material will be activated shortly -- one on the banks of the Oder River, the other in the quarry section of Wroclaw.

FUNDS ALLOTTED FOR SEWERAGE IN WARSAW -- Zycie Warszawy, No 203, 26 Jul 49

The sum of 35 million zlotys has been assigned for the construction of a new sewage system in Grochow around Kobielska and Ostrobramska streets.

The sum of 85 million zlotys has been assigned to extend the sewage system to the central part of Praga.

The sum of 68 million zlotys has been assigned for laying of new sidewalks and roads in populated districts.

Three million zlotys will be used to rebuild the bath house at the former "Polus" recreation center and 13 million for a few playgrounds.

Fourteen million zlotys will be used for new street lighting in Targowek, and 6 million for lighting of other streets of the city.

WORK BEGINS ON NEW PLANTS IN WROCLAW -- Rzeczpospolita, No 203, 26 Jul 49

The following construction was begun in Wroclaw on 22 July: a paint and varnish plant, at the Harbor Channel, Krzywousty Street; additional buildings for the "Archimedes" plant; and a coffee-processing factory on Stalin Street.

PROGRESS MADE ON COMMUNICATIONS BUILDING -- Zycie Warszawy, No 203, 26 Jul 49

About 180 workers are employed on the construction of a new building for the Ministry of Communications. It is expected the building will be completed, except for finishing appointments, this year. A hotel, restaurant, and club rooms, will also be included in the Ministry of Communications building project. It will be available for occupancy in October.

BUILDING REPAIRS HIT RED TAPE -- Zycie Warszawy, No 203, 26 Jul 49

About 130 million zlotys have been assigned for the repair of 57 residential buildings [in Warsaw?]. Eighty-seven hundred tenants, most of them wage-earners, will benefit from these repairs. However, red tape in certain Central Sales Offices is blamed for difficulties in procuring some building materials.
