CAUCASUS BUS LINES EXPAND NEW ROAD UNDER CONSTRUCTION NEAR CHITA

TBILISI TROLLEY SYSTEM GROWS -- Zarya Vostoka, No 140, 19 Jul 49

During June the trolley system of Thilisi carried more than 11 million passengers, 500,000 more than provided for by the plan.

The Tbilisi Streetcar and Trolleybus Administration has received seven new trolleybuses. Most of the new buses will operate between Ploshchad Geroyev Sovetskogo Scyuza and the Dom Spetsialistov in Saburtalo.

NEW BUS LINES IN AZERBAYDZHAN -- Bakinskiy Rabochiy, No 140, 19 Jul 49

The Ministry of Automobile Transport Azerbaydzhan SSR is expanding the system of bus lines and increasing the taxi park. The Dzhebra11-Makhmudly, Shemakha-Akhsu, and Baku-Kuba lines were recently opened. In July lines will be opened between Paryagino and Goradiz and the station of Akara and Kubatly. A system of bus lines will serve & yoginskiy, Kubatlinskij. Zhdanovskiy, and other rayons of the Republic.

Pobeda taxis are being used in Baku and will be introduced in Kirovabad and Stepanakert.

CONSTRUCTION PROGRESSES ON NEW CHITA ROAD -- Zabaykal'skiy Rabochiy, No 113, 11 Jun 49

An extensive construction program is underway on the road between the Chita Biologicals Factory and Ugdan. A number of organizations and enterprises are participating in the work. Workers of the "Barguzinzolototrans" (Barguzin Gold Transport) Trust have been particularly outstanding, building 8 kilometers of gravel and earth road. A total of 23 kilometers of now roadbed will be built here.
