ESTABLISH NINGSIA PEOPLE'S GOVERNMENT;
SET UP MILITARY CONTROL COMMISSIONS

P'AN TZU-LI NAMED GOVERNOR -- Wen-hui Pao, 31 Oct 49

Hsi-an, 31 October -- The Ningsia People's government was formally established on 29 October by order of the Shensi-Kansu-Ningsia Border Region government. P'an Tzu-li (Ueda: 6534, 9602, 856) has been designated governor, Li Ching-lin (4735, 4558, 4803), Ma Hung-pin (13680, 14446, 11386), and Sun Tien-ta'ai (2282, 5809, 3661), first, second, and third deputy governor, respectively, and Yang Te-chih (5123, 3172, 3194) and Chn Min (4717, 4262), committeemen.

SHAN-T'OU MILITARY CONTROL COMMISSION -- Kung-shang Jih-pao, 24 Oct 49

Shan-wei, 23 October -- The Shan-t'ou Military Control Commission was formally established on 22 October with Tseng Sheng (Ueda: 4661, 7461) as chairman and Liu Yung-sheng (840, 5957, 7461) as deputy chairman. Huang Ta-yuan (14693, 13029, 6310), manager of the Mtn-sheng Textile Mill in Shan-t'ou, reported that the Communist occupation of the city was carried out smoothly after the evacuation by the KMT forces. Although unconfirmed, it is said that the Communist leaders of Kwangtung are planning to designate Tseng Sheng as mayor of Shan-t'ou.

Hsia-men MILITARY CONTROL COMMISSION -- Wen-hui Pao, 28 Oct 49

Hsia-men, 27 October (NCNA) -- The Hsia-men Military Control Commission was formally established on 20 October 1949 by order of the East China Military District Headquarters with Yeh Fei (Ueda: 9966, 13495) and Huang Hsiao-hsing (14693, 6776, 4499) as chairman and deputy chairman, respectively. On 21 October, the Hsia-men People's Government was formally set up by order of the Fukien Provincial Government. Liang Ling-kuang (4967, 13092, 567) was designated governor and Chang Wei-tzu (3065, 8879, 9830), deputy governor.

COMMISSION ESTABLISHES INDUSTRIAL SECTION -- Wen-hui Pao, 31 Oct 49

Shang-hai, 31 October -- The industrial section of the East China Finance and Economics Commission was recently established to coordinate the industrial reconstruction activities of the East China area. With the exception of the textile industry, all other government-operated industries and mining enterprises are to be placed under the jurisdiction of this department.

MILITARY COUNCIL ESTABLISHES MILITARY DISTRICT -- Hua-ch'iao Jih-pao, 25 Nov 49

Khang-chou, 17 November -- The Headquarters and Political Section of the Kwangtung Military District of the People's Liberation Army were formally established on 16 November 1949 by order of the People's Revolutionary Military Affairs Council. The same order appointed Yeh Chien-ying as commandant and political commissioner of the Military District, Teng Hua (Ueda: 12223, 9921), Hung Hsueh-chih (6134, 2293, 4569), and Tseng Sheng (4661, 7461) as first, second, and third deputy commanders; Lai Ch'uan-chu (11411, 468, 7291), Lin P'ing (4803, 2899) and Feng Pai-chu (13682, 7709, 13702) as first, second, and third deputy political commissioners; Hsiao Hsiang-jung (10128, 1179, 5210) as head of the political section (cheng-chih pu); and Yang K'ang-hua (5123, 2962, 9921) as deputy head of the political section.
