WEATHER FORECAST FOR 12 - 22 AUGUST

12 August 1950. Temporary reduction of cloudiness and slackening of winds during the night. Predominantly variable cloudiness during the day, with moderate northeast winds. Minimum temperature adoubt degrees (above, Stalin, under -2 degrees); maximum, 21-28 (all degrees given centigrade).

13 August 1950. Sunny weather in the morning, with slight cloudiness. Summer cloudiness will develop in the afternoon, with thin, high cloudiness in western Bulgaria. Low northeast winds. Maximum temperature, 26-28 degrees.

15 August 1950. During the day, sunny with variable cloudiness, very pronounced in the afternoon, principally in western Bulgaria. Low, predominantly east winds. Maximum temperature, 29-34 degrees; along the Black Sea, 25-27.

16 August 1950. Predominantly sunny and warm during the day over most of the country, with the appearance of thin, high cloudiness from the west. Pronounced summer cloudiness will develop in western Bulgaria around noon and in the afternoon. Low to moderate east winds, which will later change to west winds in western Bulgaria. Minimum temperature in basin areas, 11-15 degrees; in other places, 15-20 degrees. Maximum temperature, 28-33 degrees; along the Black Sea, under 28.

17 August 1950. Sunny during the day with variable cloudiness. Stratus in the morning, pronounced summer cloudiness in the afternoon, principally over the highland regions of western Bulgaria. Low to moderate east winds, changing to moderate west winds in the afternoon in western Bulgaria, Maximum temperature, 28-34 degrees; along the Black Sea, 28

18 Avgust 1950. Predominantly sunny in the morning, with slight cloudiness. Pronounced cloudiness in the afternoon, associated with brief local showers. Low to moderate, predominatly east winds. Minimum temperature, 15-18 degrees; maximum, 29-32.

19 August 1950. During the day, predominantly sunny and warm in eastern Bulgaria. Western Bulgaria cloudiness will come from the west in the morning and there will be light rain locally, principally in the afternoon and cover the

20 August 1950. Predominantly sunny during the day with variable cloudiness, very pronounced in the afternoon when there will be light local rains, principally over the highland regions. Iow to moderate northwest winds. Maximum temperature, 29-34 degrees; along the Black Sea, under 29.

22 August 1950. Scattered and variable, but pronounced cloudiness during the day; gradual influx of cool weather from the northeast. Moderate northeast winds. Maximum temperature in southern Bulgaria, 30-32 degrees; innorthern Bulgaria, 24-28.
