MANUFACTURING FIGURES FOR 1949 -- Berlin, Chemische Industrie, No 4, Apr 50

According to figures published by the Czechoslovak statistical office, the country's 1949 production included the following (in tons):

INCREASE TRUCK PRODUCTION -- Vienna, Verkehr, 10 Aug 50

Production and export of trucks in Czechoslovakia are steadily increasing. In 1947 truck production amounted to 182 percent of the 1946 level, 243 percent in 1948, and 252 percent in 1949. Production costs have been dropping since 1946.
