WILL RECRUIT 5,000 MINERS

The Council of Ministers has issued a resolution approving the appeal of the miners at Tatabanya for the recruitment of 5,000 new miners. The resolution emphasizes the fact that the miners at Tatabanya have recognized the importance of a speedy expansion in coal production for the fulfillment of the Five-Year Plan.

The Minister of Mining and Power was directed by the Council of Ministers to secure adequate provisions, lodgings, and transportation for new miners. It is also the duty of the minister to provide for speedy and adequate technical training so that the recruited men may become skilled miners in a year's time. The head of the Office of Manpower Reserve and the presidents of the county and town councils have been directed by the Council of Ministers to organize the recruitment of new miners and to secure fast transportation to the place of employment.

The Council of Ministers has called on workers in villages and towns to volunteer for mine work and to send 5,000 new miners to the "coal battlefield." Old miners must also lend support to the recruitment drive. Finally, the Council of Ministers has called on the old as well as the new miners to eliminate the delay in the plan fulfillment, meet the coal quotas, and produce more and more coal.
