SIGN HUNGARIAN-FINNISH TRADE PROTOCOL

On 3 November 1951, a protocol was signed by Finland and Hungary which forms the 1952 supplement to the trade agreement of 1948. The volume of trade for each party was set at 3.5 million dollars.

Among other products, Finland will deliver 25,000 railroad ties, 35,000 cubic meters of wood, 500 tons of sulfate cellulose, 2,500 tons of wood pulp, 270 tons of technical paper, including carbon paper, 300 tons of synthetic fiber, 400 tons of sawdust, and 400,000 dollars worth of machinery.

Hungary will export (in dollar values): medicinal plants and alkaloids, 150,000; electrical instruments, 150,000; insulators, 100,000; optical and precision instruments, 120,000; machinery, 200,000; cotton cloth, 300,000; photographic paper, 120,000. She will also export 1,000 tons of sugar, 300 tons of buckwheat, 400 tons of peas, chemicals, etc.
