## ANTI-COMMUNIST GUERRILLA ACTIVITIES IN SOUTH AND EAST CHIMA

RECEGANIZE ANTI-COMMUNIST GUERRILLAS IN KWANGTURT KWANGSI -- Hong Kong Zeingteo Jih-pgc, 17 Jun 52

In the past, armed anti-Communist guarrilla forces in the Kwangtung-Amagni eress had been very active, but their activities have been greatly restricted as a result of the Communist large-scale mopping-up campaigns launched during the past year, An order was issued by the IMT government to all guerrilles to go underground to focus their activities on the collection of intelligence information.

A report from a T'ai-pei military source discloses that the KM Kinistry of Estimal Perense has assembled guerrilla leaders and military specialists to stone and make over-all plans for the role to be played by the guerrillas in the event of a lift counteroffencive on the mainland. Steps have also been taken, the source further reported, to abolish the complicated generalla syrtem, to overcome command difficulties, to reorganize the mainland guerrills forces, to peplace the old identification spaces, and to assign new leadership. Perganizations undertaken were: (1) sen belonging to the local (til-fang) guerrills forces were incorporated into the Pacification Army (sui-ching chun), and (2) forces under direct command of the Ministry of We tional Defense were renamed field armies (yeh-chan chu).

Edich Tulk (1) Inumbers in parentheses refer to appended characters 1s to continue as the top commander of the Facification Army in Kwangtung, while Chang Jui-kmei (2), Yeh Shao (3), Huang Kuo-liang (4), and Yung Yu-lu (5 are to be his subordinates acting as commanders of the various command posts of this army. Li Pin-hein (6) is to assume command of the Kwangsi Facification Army.

It is reported that the Taiwan government has alread, sent an officer to the Ministry of National Defense.

KMT GUERRIJIAS IANT IN CHEKIANG -- Hong Kong, Kung-shang Jih-pao, 15 Jun 52

Information from a reliable source discloses that on 10 June 1952 over 1,000 kMT guerrillas made a landing in Southern Chakking and attacked the Huang-chico area. They penetrated several miles inland, and wiped out 500 Chinese Communist troops. These guerrillas are remaining in this area.

3,000 MEDERT CCF IN KWANGSI -- Hong Kong, Kung-shang Jih-p.o, 7 Jun 52

A recent report states that a deputy commander of a CCF regiment led 3,000 officers and men under his command to desert the Chinese Communist "Vietnam Volunteer Forces" and joined forces with the anti-Communist guerrillan.

ANTI-COMMUNIST GUERRILIAS ATTACK COASTAL VILLAGE -- Houg Kong. Kung-shang Jih-pao, 4 Jul 52

(Chung-lien She) -- With the clandestine aid of ten Chinese Communist militiamen, anti-Communist guerrillas successfully attacked Sha-chiang Hsiang, Hai-feng Hsien, Kwangtung, on 25 June 1952. These guerrillas entered the village at about 0100 hours, surrounded the militia unit, and captured the militia commander, Chien Piu (7), hsiang chief, Chien Hua-chao (8), and six Communist cadres.

The guerrillas then spread anti-Communist propaganda. Upon completing their mission, the guerrillas executed the Communist leaders and cadres, and then left the area with the ten militiamen who midd them.

HO-P'ING HS\EM ATTACKED BY GUERRILLAS -- Hong Kong, Kung-shalg Jih-pao, 27 Jun 52

According to a Chung-yang She report, at 0200 hours, on 18 June 1952, scale 400 Kwangtung-Awangsi border area guerrillas attacked Ho-p'ing Hsien. Li Shao-wu (9), deputy hsien magistrate and concurrently public security bureau chief, was killed. Chou Lin (10) commander of the public security battalion (ta-tui), set fire to the public security building and led 70 members unler his command to revolt against the Communists, and then joined forces with the guerrillas. While withdrawing, the guerrillas, joined by the deserters, blaw up seven bridges along the Ho-p'ing -- Lien-p'ing highway.

GUERRILLAS LAND IN FOOCHOW AREA -- Hong Kong, Kung-shang Jih-pao, 2 Jul 52

Chung-yang She reports that a group of KMT guerrillas on the Pai-kou-shan islands, outside the Foochow estuary, made a landing in the western Foochow area and attacked the Communist forces in early Nue. Sung Shih-lun's (11) men of the Third Field Army opposed the landing but were forced to retreat. Before withdrawing, the guerrillas blasted the locks and bosts in Ta-lung Wan, demaging 39 Communist gumbonts which were being propared for active duty.
