INCREASE IN OUTPUT OF SPARE PARTS  
AND TRUCK REPAIR FACILITIES OF PLANTS

PARTS PLANT TO DOUBLE OUTPUT -- Yerevan, Kommunist, 11 Sep 52

The Yerevan Avtodetal' Plant will double its gross production during the new Five-Year Plan.

By increasing the hardness of spline shafts for ZIS-5 trucks, the life span of the shaft was tripled. In a 2-year period, the plant cut the labor time involved in producing a spline shaft from 3.84 to 2.05 hours.

In 1952, the plant will double its 1950 production of spline shafts. In 1953, it will produce two and one half times as much as in 1950.

The plant increased the cutting speed of spline-grinding machines from 26 meters to between 47 and 50 meters per second and thus doubled their output. Many of the plant's machines are not adapted to high-speed cutting and retard the expansion of this method.

TRAKTORODETAL' PLANT FULFILLS PLAN -- Stalinabad, Kommunist Tadzhikistana, 5 Oct 52

The Stalinabad Traktorodetal' Plant has fulfilled its September 1952 plan for gross production by 119.5 percent, and for commodity output by 124.3 percent. The plant now remelts iron shavings in a cupola furnace and has installed a new electric-gas case-hardening furnace.

PLANT FILLS QUOTA EARLY -- Tashkent, Pravda Vostoka, 23 Oct 52

The Tashkent Avtotraktorodetal' Plant fulfilled its 9-month plan ahead of schedule and had turned out 1,235,000 rubles worth of above-plan output by 1 October. Production costs were reduced 11.1 percent and labor productivity raised 24 percent. One million rubles were accumulated above the plan. The plant fulfilled the plan for automatic saw sharpeners, used in cotton plants of the Uzbek SSR, by 140 percent.

The Leningrad Carburetor Plant imeni Kuybyshev shipped a large consignment of spare parts for 25-ton dump trucks to the Stalingrad and Kuybyshev GES projects 2 weeks ahead of schedule.

RIGA PLANT MEETS PLAN -- Riga, Sovetskaya Latvija, 1 Nov 52

The Riga Avtoelektropribor Plant fulfilled the plan for the first 10 months of 1952 by 104 percent. Recently, it organized the output of three new types of automotive instruments.

TRUCK-REPAIR CAPACITY INCREASED -- Frunze, Sovetskaya Kirgiziya, 12 Nov 52

The Osh Motor Repair Plant has set up three constant flow lines for repairing ZIS-5, GAZ-51, and GAZ-AA trucks. The plant will repair three times as many truck and tractor engines in 1953 as it did in 1952.
