GOODS MANUFACTURED BY USSR METALLURGICAL PLANTS

Moscow, Izvestiya, 10 Jan 54

The Moscow Serp i Molot Metallurgical Plant ships its output to about 1,000 industrial organizations. The plant manufactures sheet, tool, calibrated, and ball bearing steel, cable, bimetallic wire, stainless sheet, and high-quality castings. The steel manufactured by the plant is used in machines, tractors, automobiles, milk cans, precision instruments, bed springs, refrigerators, toys, rails, structural members, statues, and excavator and turbine parts. In 1953, the plant overfulfilled its quota by thousands of tons of steel.

Frunze, Sovetskaya Kirgiziya, 14 Oct 53

The Dnepropetrovsk Metallurgical Plant imeni Petrovskiy has shipped several carloads of angle iron to Stavropol'skiy Kray MFS. The Dnepropetrovsk Metallurgical Plant imeni Lenin has shipped about 500 tons of water pipe ahead of schedule to kolkhozes of Kabardinskaya ASSR and surrounding oblasts.

Moscow, Trud, 6 Oct 53

The Kazakh Metallurgical Plant has shipped over 2,000 tons of small section rolled stock to rural consumers cooperatives.

Moscow, Trud, 15 Jul 52

The Stalino, Zhdanov, Makeyevka, and Yenakiyev Metallurgical Plants have shipped over 87,000 tons of section steel, 14,000 tons of sheet iron and channel beams, and 9,730 tons of pipe to the Volga-Don Canal project.

Vil'nyus, Sovetskaya Litva, 22 Jun 52

The Magnitogorsk Metallurgical Combine imeni Stalin shipped a large consignment of narrow-gauge rails to Kuybyshevgidrostroy (Kuybyshevskaya GES Construction Administration) on 21 June 1952.

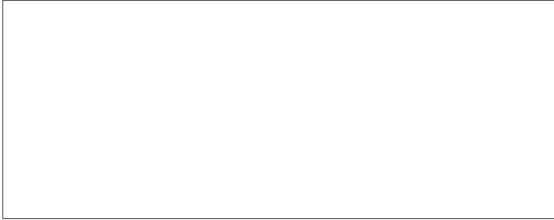
Moscow, Izvestiya, 19 Jun 52
