1. Comment. Possibly, troop shipments.

2. Comment. The 1,447 loadings in August 1952 which included 364 with undetermined cargo indicate that, compared with the previous month, supply traffic decreased by about 30 percent. This decrease is primarily due to uncomplete coverage of small shipments dispatched by small railroad stations. The large supply centers, such as Dresden, Riesa, Chermnitz, Reissen and Roederau show only slight fluctuations in the volume of supply as over the previous month. The number of shipments and traffic relations are considered normal.

3. Comment. The two trains are believed to have carried more billeting equipment of the 44th Gds Tank Regt of the 11th Gds Tank Div to Koenigsbrueck.

4. Comment. It is believed that a unit of the 6th Gds AAA Div (US) was transferred to the Koenigsbrueck troop training grounds.

5. Comment. The trains carried elements of the 220th Hvy Tank SP Regt. The regiment can therefore be carried as confirmed until 20 August. It is assumed that elements of units which were transferred to Letzling Heath in August returned to the post on 1 September.

6. Comment. The 112th Gds Mtz Rifle Regt of the 39th Gds Mtz Rifle Div conducted a field exercise at the local troop training grounds of the Kobitzschwalde post near Plauen from 23 to 25 August. The maneuver also involved 15 JS-3 tanks of the 220th Hvy Tank SP Regt from Glauchau. The trains carried the tank units to and from the troop training grounds.

7. Comment. The train on 15 August carried elements of the 87th Gun Arty Regt stationed in Plauen. The train on 31 August possibly carried elements of the 112th Gds Mtz Rifle Regt.

8. Comment. It has previously been observed that tractors were dispatched from Dresden to various airfields and vice versa. It is therefore assumed that an air force supply unit handling the motor vehicle supply for the elements of the Twenty-Fourth Air Army is stationed in Dresden.

9. Comment.

At the end of August and in the beginning of September 1952, vehicles of all army signal units were observed in Stalag I in Luckenwalde. a shipment of a signal unit from Luckenwalde to Dresden on 3 September. It is now clear, that the unit left on 30 August and returned on 3 September. the signal regiment of the 1st Gds Mecz Army is carried in the Adolf Hitler Kaserne on the south side of Kurt Fischer Allee in Dresden.
