- 1. [redacted] a troop train of 5 cars [redacted] went from Dranse to Seddin on 24 December 1952.
- 2. [redacted] 18 converted boxcars were to be made available on 23 December, and another 16 converted boxcars on 24 December at the Frankfurt/Oder railroad station. The cars had to be transitworthy and suitable for operations under winter conditions.¹
- 3. Troop trains to Falkenberg [redacted] between 26 and 28 December included: a train of 3 converted boxcars, 22 boxcars, 16 flatcars and 5 tank cars from Wustermark, [redacted] on 26 December; a train of 17 boxcars and 18 flatcars from Dallgow-Doeberitz on 27 December; and a train of 27 boxcars, 14 flatcars and 5 tank cars from Wustermark, [redacted] on 28 December.²
